Please note: Saturday mock examination preparation classes are compulsory in the term before the grade examinations and intensive examination classes will be held during the first week of the September/October holidays. 30th September – 5th October

TERM FEES:

Fees are payable the FIRST WEEK OF EACH TERM. Overdue accounts incur a penalty of \$30.00
Notification of withdrawal from a class must be advised within the first three weeks, or full term fees will be charged.

A rebate of \$10.00 per term for a second or more members of a family is allowable.

All classes are of one hour duration, except Pre School and Pre Primary and Junior Contemporary = $\frac{3}{4}$ hour and grades 5, 6, 7 and 8 are 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours. Intermediate and Advanced Foundation = 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours.

The HOWICK DANCE STUDIO was established in 1992.

Mrs. Sharon Barber - Principal was trained by Royal Academy examiners, Nancy Algar-Rowe in Tauranga and Creina Gee in Auckland, and further trained in Auckland at the Auckland Ballet Academy and in London at R.A.D. Headquarters, towards her teaching diploma and qualified in 1991. Mrs. Barber taught at the Auckland Ballet Academy in Remuera for four years before leaving to establish her own school as well as teaching part time at the Uxbridge Community Centre in Howick. Mrs. Barber attends courses in U.K. every second year. In 2010 she completed Level I Pilates mat work series.

Mr. Ichiro Harada is currently the Dance tutor at Saint Kentigen College. Mr. Harada graduated from Boston Conservatory with BFA in dance and has danced worldwide. As choreographer his pieces have been performed in many cities in Japan as well as in Russia, Australia, Korea and New York.

BALLET CLASSES:

Pre School, Pre Primary, Primary, Grades 1 - 8, Vocational –Intermediate, Advanced Foundation, Advanced One, Advanced Two, Open Ballet

PRE SCHOOL: dance classes aim to develop children's co-ordination and musicality. The classes involve movement to music with songs, nursery rhymes and mime - use of props and instruments. These classes are for children aged from 3-5 years of age - a fun introduction to the world of dancing.

PRE PRIMARY ballet classes are the progression from Pre School Dance for children aged 5. This is an introduction to ballet, still involving mime and musical interpretation, as well as the basics of ballet movement.

All classes are trained in the Royal Academy of Dancing syllabi. Pre Primary, Primary and Grade 1 attend one class per week and from Grade 2 upwards, twice a week, to ensure a high standard is achieved.

VOCATIONAL classes involve pointe work and the examinations are designed for students wishing to pursue a career in dance..

R.A.D. grade and vocational examinations are held at the Howick Dance Studio every year. Students need not be entered for examinations and will be progressed normally through the grades, however, the studio does encourage the children to enter for the examinations.

CONTEMPORARY OPEN CLASSES are now available Mondays 5.00-5.45 Juniors and Seniors 7.15 – 8.15.

HOLIDAY DANCE COURSES The Howick Dance Studio offers grade and vocational courses during the third term holiday break as examination coaching classes. These classes are **compulsory** for students wishing to sit end of year examinations.

CONCERT: A huge theatre concert is produced every other year at mid year and is open to ballet students from Pre Primary level – age 5 upwards. Our first production in 1992 was –

“Nursery Rhyme, Suite, London Street Scene and Red Riding Hood” with over 100 children participating. The second production in 1993 was “The Snow Queen” with 200 children participating, “Cinderella” was next in 1995, “Coppelia” in 1997, “Sleeping Princess” in 1999, “Nutcracker” in 2001, “Alice in Wonderland” in 2003, “Little Mermaid” in 2005, “Cinderella” in 2007, “Peter Pan” in 2009, “La Fille mal Gardee” in 2011, “Sleeping Beauty” in 2013, “Alice in Wonderland” in 2015, “Little Mermaid” in 2017. This year we will reproduce The Nutcracker.

The in house choreographic team also produce a mini production at the end of the year - “Dance on Elliott”

UNIFORM: The regulations regarding correct wearing of uniform are to maintain a high standard of dress within the studio, and to give pupils a sense of pride in their appearance, assisting with their dance training discipline.

Howick Dance Studio uniform is compulsory for all classes EXCEPT Pre School.
